NOTICE TO ALL MUNICIPAL WATER USERS

Lawn Watering Restrictions

Water users on the Arnow, Tiverton, Scott's Point, Underwood and Kincardine water systems including Huronville and the pipeline to Inverhuron; please note that as per By-law number 2009-079 a lawn watering restriction is in effect from May 15 to September 30.

Section 2, subsection 2.2 states that "no person shall irrigate with a watering device any lawn, garden, tree, shrub, or other outdoor plant except on the applicable days provided below and except between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 9:00 p.m. on the applicable days:

- a) For all premises with even street numbers, on even numbered calendar days;
- b) For all premises with odd street numbers, on odd numbered calendar days"

Distribution System Flushing

Hydrant and distribution system flushing will take place on the following days during the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.:

Kincardine including Huronville and the pipeline to Inverhuron May 6 to June 14

Please note that periods of discoloration may take place during flushing. Reducing your water usage during flushing hours will help to minimize the amount of sediment and discoloration introduced into your household system. Household cold water taps may need to be flushed for several minutes and screens cleaned after distribution flushing has occurred prior to using the water. 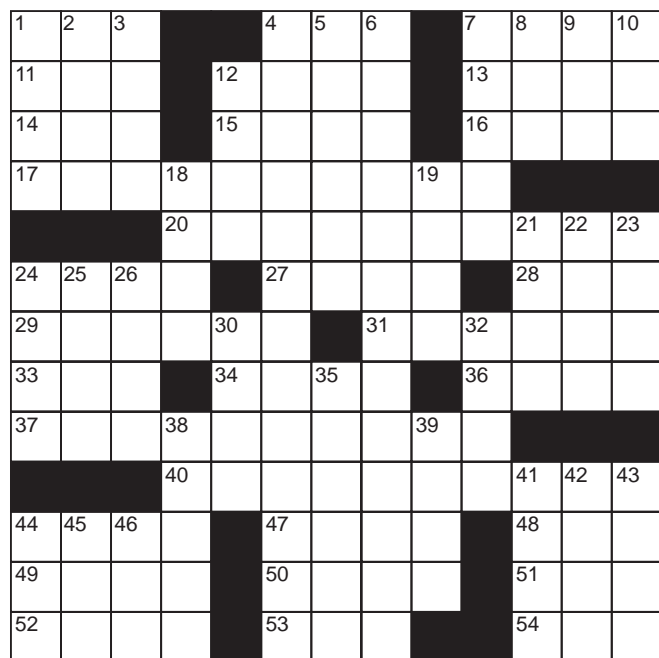
