Heritage Conservation District Study

The Heritage Conservation District study was initiated by the Municipality of Kincardine in the summer of 2019 and Stantec Consulting Ltd. was retained to complete the project. In order to understand its character, the HCD study will identify and evaluate heritage resources, including buildings, landscapes, and streetscapes in the following areas: Princes Street (from Lambton Street South to 669 Princes Street), Durham Market North, Durham Market South, Queen Street (from Lambton to Durham Market South).

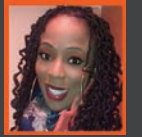

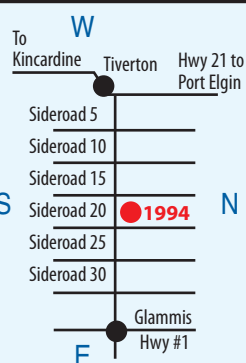
